





Principles of Lightweight Backpacking

- 1. Take enough gear to be safe, comfortable and confident.
- 2. Know the actual weight of each item.
- 3. Whenever possible, use multipurpose items.
- 4. Look at the heaviest items first.
- 5. When selecting items, use the smallest items that will suit your needs.
- Choose lightweight gear that is useful, sturdy and dependable.







Packing Categories

No.	Description	Notes
1	Risk Management	Know before you go: weather forecast, terrain, route and water sources.
2	Pack Weight	My objective is 10-12 lbs
3	Footwear	Trail shoes or low cut hiking boots
4	Backpacks	Gossamer Gear Mariposa
5	Navigation	Map, compass, GPS
7	Clothing System	Weather protection, thermoregulation and layers
8	Sleep System	Sleeping bag or quilt, pad, sleep wear
9	Shelter	Tarp tent
10	Hydration	Platypus , purification tablets
11	Food & Cooking Equipment	Plan for about 2 lbs of food per day, stove, fuel, pot/bowl/cup, spoon
12	Hygiene	Toothbrush, toothpaste (mini size)
13	First Aid	Advil, bandaids, moleskin, tweezer

What Size Shelter Do I Really Need?

Questions To Ask:

- Expected Weather conditions
- Expected Terrain conditions
- Bug conditions?
- Width per person (Standard pad width is 20")
- How many people to accommodate 1, 2, 3 or 4?
- Gear in or outside?
- Bivy Bag or Tarp or Tent W/Floor ?

One of the steps frequently undertaken when transitioning to a lighter pack, is replacing that old six pound tent for a one pound tarp. For this old tarp lover, they are great. Tarps provide lots of protected space, are open airy and give you lots of views. On the downside they do take a bit of getting used to and require more knowledge of the proper place to set them up. Once you've taken this leap, they do provide a major weight savings.

As you browse through our selection of tarps, you'll notice they aren't like your typical flat tarp. Instead all of the tarps we design and manufacture are Shaped Tarps. Flat tarps can be setup in a host of configurations, but unless you're an expert in Origami, invariably one side will be exposed to the weather. Shaped Tarps are designed to ensure a full 360 degree enclosure. So when the wind and rain shifts at night you're still protected.

Shaped Tarps are also easier to setup and get a taut pitch. For more information on tarps check out our Tarp Techniques page.














Tents 🔊





Ultralight backpacking tents have significantly evolved over the last decade. These new one and a half to two pound (one to two people) tents are a far cry from the five pound tents backpackers have traditionally carried.

Their roots stem from transforming your traditional tarp by adding shape, bug protection and a floor. Like a tarp, they are designed to be both light and airy.

Newer fabrics have become available that help to save a considerable amount of weight. These tents forgo the double wall construction of traditional backpacking tents. A significant amount of weight reduction comes from eliminating your normal tent structure. By utilizing your existing hiking poles, you can forgo the weight of the tent poles, plus you're hiking poles become dual duty. By their nature, hiking poles are significantly stronger than your tent pole. This allows you to have an extremely sturdy shelter.

While these tents can significantly reduce your pack weight, they do require a bit more knowledge to get the most performance. We recommend you read both our Shelter FAQ and Shelter Tips.

ZPacks™ Hexamid Solo-Plus Tent or Tarp

Description:

The Hexamid Solo-Plus is an in-between size tent that has the same size footprint as the Hexamid Twin, but it only requires one long trekking pole to set up. It is a good compromise for solo hikers requiring more space, or for those who sometimes camp with a partner.

It is made from the lightest materials available; .51 oz/sqyd cuben fiber, and optionally .7 oz/sqyd ultralight insect netting.

 Sets up with just one trekking pole or walking stick adjusted to around 52 inches (132 cm), and a minimum of six stakes. <u>Ten</u> stakes are recommended on this tent for additional head room and wind resistance.
